

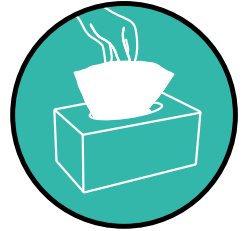
GETTING TOGETHER SAFELY

This COVID-19 Safety Plan has been prepared in accordance with the NSW Public Health Order (No 4) and is applicable to PCYC Taree (MBC Sundays | 10:30).

1 General Health Safe Guidelines

As per the NSW Health guidelines we ask anyone who is unwell or displaying possible COVID symptoms to remain at home if they are interested in participating in our gathering. For those who attend, we will encourage them to allow for 1.5m social distancing with others outside their household. These expectations will be communicated via email, social media and by displaying signs at the entry of the premises.

2 Capacity Limitations and Safe Health Processes

The capacity of our gatherings is 100, subject to the 4m² rule. People will be counted upon entry and the number of attendees will be capped once capacity has been met. We will facilitate a range of spaces for attendees to gather in before and after the service to allow for 1.5m social distancing.

We will set chair rows at a safe distance from each other and encourage 1-2 seat gaps between other people who are not a part of their household.

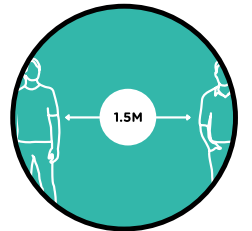
We will only have musical items (rather than congregational singing) in our services. We plan to limit singing to two singers at the front. Band members will be encouraged to maintain a safe distance between each other and the congregation.

Signage will be placed at the premises with details of capacity limits and instructions on good hand hygiene practices. We will ensure that bathrooms are well stocked with hand soap and paper towels.

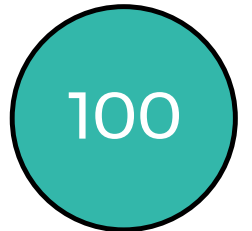
Wearing a face mask will be a condition of entry for all attending unless exempt. Face masks will be available at the entrance.

We will clean frequently used areas with disinfectant (including wiping surfaces) at the end of each church service. Disinfectant solutions will be maintained at an appropriate strength and used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Staff and volunteers will wear gloves when cleaning and wash hands thoroughly before and after with soap and water.

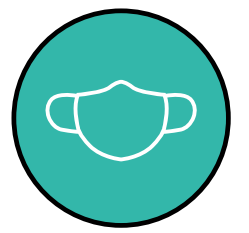
We will provide service recordings for those who may be a part of high-risk demographics or unwell.
